- b) Aasha and Bhairav got married in December 2007 under Hindu Vedic Rites, but within few days they found that they cannot live together as husband and wife. Now they want to dissolve their marriage. Advise them.
- c) Tanmayee and Roshan married under The Special Marriage Act, 1954. Roshan fell in love with Anisa, a Muslim lady. He got converted to Muslim religion and performed Nikah with Anisa. What are the legal effects of this Nikah and the remedy available to Tanmayee.
- d) Aarti and Prakash both Hindu married in 31 December 2008. After few days of their marriage, Prakash starts ill treating and assaulting Aarti. In April 2009, she went back to her parents home and approaches to the Court for dissolution of her marriage. State the legal remedy available to her.
- e) Zoya and Rameez are married under the Special Marriage Act, 1954. Rameez gives her Talaq. State the legal effects of this Talaq upon their marriage.
