The cultural Department of DES Shri Navalmal Firodia law college every year organises “Dum Indradhanush” with an objective. The primary goal of the cultural Department in a college is to create an immersive and enriching experience for participants that aligns with the broader objectives of cultural education and community engagement.

The objectives of the Cultural Department are:

Creating a Welcoming Environment: Creating a healthy and happier environment makes everyone feel included, individuals from all backgrounds feel valued and respected, thereby strengthening the sense of belonging within the college community.

Empowering Student Leadership: Through involvement in event planning, organization, and execution, the department empowers students to develop leadership skills and take ownership of their cultural programming initiatives.

Creating Lasting Memories: Ultimately, the goal is to create memorable and transformative experiences for participants that leave a lasting impact, inclusiveness, inspiring continued engagement with cultural learning and appreciation both on and off-campus.

The Cultural Department has a very active participation in the college as students from different age groups work together in order to make things better and memorable with their ideas and insights.

As of every year, this year also we have hosted DUM-INDRADHANUS, which included series of fun, sports and enthusiastic events that were performed from 18th to 23rd March. The Cultural Intra-collegiate Fest was conducted from 21st, 22nd and 23th March 2024. The Event received response from the participants around 250 students participated in various cultural events in the span of three days. Apart from participation, student who attended the event were 800 in number, which made the event a grand success.

The details of the Events conducted are as follows :-

- **Treasure Hunt-** This is an interactive activity that includes Riddles, Puzzles, and a series of clues to find a particular “Treasure”. This game develops a quality of critical thinking, promotes teamwork and helps you to learn better co-ordination among the teammates. As of this year a total of 13 teams participated and with the co ordination of event heads and volunteers the clues were hidden within the campus area
- **SINGING-** Participants performed individually with their mesmerising voices, covering the event with love, nostalgia and showcasing their talent through music.

- IMPROMPTU DANCE-. A random song was played on the spot and a time limit of 2 minutes was given to each participant to showcase their moves.
- ANTAKSHARI- This was a group activity where teams were given some random words and were asked to sing a Bollywood song containing that word in it.
- MONO ACTING- Also known as monologue acting, is a form of theatrical performance where a single actor performs alone on stage, portraying one or more characters.
- HOG FEST- Students competed against each other in terms of quantity of food that was to be eaten by them.
- SLAM POETRY- It was judged on the basis of the creativity a student added in the poems.
- CRAZY COMMERCIALS- It was a group activity where teams were asked to make unique stuffs and sell them with their ability. They were judges on the basis of their communication skills, task management, teamwork etc.
- ONE MINUTE FAME- Each participant was given 1 minute to show any of his talents like weight lifting, singing, acting or anything they're good at.
- GROUP DANCE- Artistic dances were done by the students impressing every person sitting as the audience. There were no competitions instead it was a way to spread joy and happiness among everyone.
- STANDUP COMEDY- Stand-up comedy is a form entertainment where a comedian performs in front of a live audience, typically delivering a series of humorous stories, jokes, observations, and anecdotes.
- RANGOLI AND MEHENDI- Participants showed the talent of their artistic work by making beautiful Mehendi and Rangoli.
- HOLD IT, HAVE IT- The goal of the game is to be the last player remaining in the game by holding an object.
- PAINTING AND POSTER MAKING- The paintings and posters were judged by the amount of creativity and smart work.
