The Cultural Department of a College aims to provide a platform for students to showcase their talents, promote cultural diversity, and foster community engagement. This policy document outlines the guidelines and procedures for conducting cultural events and activities within the college.

Objectives:

The objectives of the Cultural Department are:

- a) To provide an opportunity for students to develop their creative and artistic talents.
- b) To celebrate cultural diversity and foster mutual respect for different cultures and traditions.
- c) To promote inclusivity and community engagement through cultural events and activities.
- d) To provide a platform for students to interact and network outside of the classroom

The cultural department has always been an active part of the college. This year as every year we hosted our Intra collegiate Fest Indradhanush. We had a series of events lined up that were performed on 11th, 12th and 13th of May 2023. The details of which are as follows-

1. One Minute Fame – The one minute fame was meant for students to showcase their talent in one minute. Each of them was given one minute and the performers could dance, sing or showcase any talent.
2. Bollywood Quiz- The bollywood quiz was based on questions asked on old Hindi films and songs. There were teams made class wise and students enthusiastically participated in the event.
3. Mehendi- Mehendi was an event in which students and teachers participated likewise. The competition was based on designs and creativity.
4. Hog Fest- This was the competition where students competed in terms of quantity of food that was eaten.
5. Painting- The painting competition was judged on the basis of creativity and design.
6. Mad ads- This was where students were asked to perform ads that were crazy yet entertaining and educating.
7. Impromptu Dance- this was the competition where performers were asked to dance to the music that was played on the spot.
8. Musical Chair- Class wise competition was conducted for this event.
9. Treasure hunt- The event aimed to promote teamwork, critical thinking, effective communication, and time management skills among participants.

Spanning for over an hour, a massive participation of eight enthusiastic teams was witnessed for the hunt this year. The clues were cleverly hidden in various secretive spots in the campus, the ambit of which was from the Kimaya Cultural and Recreation Centre, to Gate No. 4.

The clues were designed to be difficult yet decipher-able, with each team getting a variety of five. It was ensured that each team gets a set that progresses towards difficulty as they approach the final clue, the one hidden in the Moot Court Hall.

They were provided Rangoli by the college. The event was challenging for the participants as they were given only an hour to complete their Rangolis, but each one of them did a commendable job. Amruta Shirole of 1st LL.B emerged the winner while Sharwari Konde of 2nd BA.LLB was the runner-up. Amruta's Rangoli of Lord Vitthal was an absolute hit and it garnered a lot of praise.
